We are pleased to be launching our sixth year of our Start The Music scheme on Thursday 18th April at 7.30pm in the Main Hall at St Aidan's.

St Aidan's 'Start the Music' applications are open to all pupils starting in Y7 who want to learn a musical instrument. On a successful application, pupils will receive free lessons for a year and the loan of an instrument if appropriate. Our scheme is open to pupils who have not played an instrument before and also pupils who are looking to start a second instrument from the endangered instrument list (oboe, bassoon, French horn, tenor horn, tuba, clarinet, alto or tenor saxophone). We would welcome applicants in particular wishing to learn the saxophone, tenor horn, tuba and French horn. Please note, there are some instruments we don't support in the scheme this year such as piano, percussion, drums and trumpet.

For more information please come along to our launch evening on Thursday 18th April at 7pm when St Aidan's Junior band and String ensemble will be performing. We are also excited to have a visiting quartet to perform this year, Nebula Brass (featuring one of our ex-students and tenor horn player, George Fearnley) from the Royal Welsh College of Music.
