School is closed to students on **Friday 28 June** as it is a training day.

Reminder - Great Yorkshire Show. No teaching for Y12 on Tuesday 9 and Wednesday 10

As you will already be aware, the Great Yorkshire Show takes place from Tuesday 9 – Friday 12 July this year. Due to the considerable number of students in main school attending the event at both St Aidan's and St John Fisher on Tuesday 9 and Wednesday 10, it will not be possible to offer teaching in school for year 12 students on these days. Therefore, we are directing students in year 12 to spend these two days doing the following:

- Attending the GYS for one of the days in order to support the community in this important event
- Visiting Universities and attending open days where possible to help to prepare for UCAS applications following the careers day next week in school
- Completing on-line courses and on-line work experience opportunities
- Completing Core learning for their A-level subjects, posted on the class Teams by their teachers.

School will run as normal on Monday 8, Thursday 11 and Friday 12 July.

A reminder also that the Library will be closed for a stock check 8-10 July, so Y12 students should work in the study centre on 8 July (9 and 10 July – Y12 not in school – see above).
