Whilst you still have a lovely long summer ahead of you, we are making contact to confirm arrangements for GCSE results day. Collecting your GCSE results is probably the first time you've received official academic results in person and we hope to make this process as straightforward as possible.

#### **Collection of results in person by students**

On GCSE results day, Thursday 21 August, students should make their way to Constance Green Hall where results will be available from 8am. We really hope that most students will collect results in person as there will be lots of familiar staff available on the day, to celebrate and provide support as necessary.

#### **Collection of results by an adult**

Students may nominate an adult to collect their results on their behalf if they are unable to collect in person. The nominated person must bring photo ID with them. Students cannot collect another student's results. Results can also be emailed to a students' school email account on request. ***Please be aware that results will be emailed later in the day after the in-person collection has finished.***

Results envelopes that are not collected will be posted to your home address at the end of the day on 21 August. Please may we ask that you update any changes of address with our school office.
