

Priority service 2

via Interchange and Cambridge Technicals in the June series. Request available for Level 3 qualifications including AS and A Levels Review of marking (£80.25) – as for service 2, but only

Service 2a and 2b

Review of marking (£141.25/£301.50) for <u>Cambridge</u>
<u>Technicals Performing Arts</u> units and <u>general qualification</u>
<u>components</u> where access to scripts is not available. Request via Interchange.

Service 3

Copy of script

A PDF copy of the reviewed script (free) to be made available after the review has been completed.

Missing and incomplete results (MIR)

applied (free). Request via Interchange partial absence (#) or pending (Q) – has been wrongly An investigation to check if a result indicator – no result (X),

Late certification

Request when a certification entry has not been made for a Cambridge Nationals qualification, or for AS and A Level Further Maths and History (**free**). Request <u>via Interchange</u>.
