Medication

Occasional unseasonable cold weather

- •Fleece/warm jumper

- Light waterproof jacket
- Nice summer clothes for the evenings
- Hat/cap
- Water bottle
- Cord for glasses
- •No denim or vests for watersports•Sleeping bag should be warm.
- •T shirts rather than vests on activities during the day as they reduce sunburn.
- High factor WATERPROOF sun cream is a must.
- •Insect repellent is also a good idea.
- •Old sunglasses for the Ardeche.
